The Scottish Karting Championship has a proud history of developing talented drivers who have gone on to achieve success at the very highest levels of motorsport.

Scottish racing legends including David Coulthard, Allan McNish, Dario Franchitti and Susie Wolff all began their careers in Scottish karting before becoming recognised names on the world stage.

The Scottish Karting Championship is an annual event hosted on a rotational basis by Scotland's four karting clubs. Competitors race for the honour of becoming Scottish Champion in their respective class and earning the right to run the coveted 'S' plate - a Motorsport UK recognised championship plate respected across British karting.

SCOTTISH KARTING GOES LIVE

The 2026 Scottish Karting Championships will be streamed live for the first time ever.

The British Kart Championships and other major karting championships across the UK are broadcast live – and now, for the first time ever, a Scottish karting event will join them.

The Scottish Karting Championship will be professionally live streamed by Karting Live TV, featuring full race coverage, expert commentary, paddock interviews and event coverage throughout the weekend.

The broadcast will reach Karting Live TV's audience of more than 8,000 followers, alongside promotion across Grampian Kart Club's network of over 5,000 followers.

The 2026 Scottish Karting Championship presents sponsors with a unique opportunity to be part of a landmark moment for the sport – placing your brand in front of the UK karting audience while supporting the next generation of Scottish motorsport talent, including drivers who could one day progress to the very top levels of international racing.

KART CLASSES



BAMBINO

6-8 years old

Approx Speed: 40-45mph

The first step on the ladder for young children. Powered by the Comer C50 2 stroke with all weather tyres, these miniature karts teach young racers the foundational driving skills.



CADETS

8-12 years old

Approx Speed: 55mph

This class is split across the 4 stroke Honda GX200 and 2 stroke Rotax Max powered karts. Cadets provide some of the closest and exciting racing, often working together to catch packs and make progress.



INTERS

10-13 years old

Approx Speed: 65mph

The intermediate class uses the popular Rotax Max 125cc engine with restrictors. This class is a jump up for cadets and provides kids who are struggling to get to the minimum weight in cadets to progress.

KART CLASSES



JUNIORS

12-16 years old

Approx Speed: 70mph

The final step on the junior ladder using the Junior Rotax Max engine and sticky slick tyres. This class uses a full size chassis with pedal extensions where required.



SENIORS

16+ years old

Approx Speed: 75mph

Using the same 125cc Rotax Max base as the other classes with the addition of an exhaust valve to provide more power and stickier tyres. This class is split between a 162 and 177kgs weight category.



KZ2

16+ years old

Approx Speed: 85mph

The premier class of short circuit karting. These karts have a 6 speed sequential gearbox, 50hp and front brakes. 0-60mph in under 3 seconds these karts provide single seater performance at a fraction of the cost.
